# 5. <u>CALSTOCK CEMETERY DIG</u>

The University of Exeter has had their HLF grant approved and are likely to start their archaeological dig in the summer of 2018. Calstock Cemetery is starting to run out of space although the Deputy Clerk estimates that there are probably 100 plots left (with less than 20 being used per year). The Clerk asked Chris Smart if any part of the field could be used IF the churchyard does get full before the dig is finished but was told this would not be possible.

The Burial Board are keen to support the dig and have asked the Clerk to contact Chris Smart to see if any of the findings can be retained as visual interest.

It may be useful to have a map and plots drawn up before the dig so that the area is ready to be used on completion of the dig.

Cllr Latham commented on the remarkable work that Kevin has done in clearing the old churchyard and will talk to the Archives about whether she can use some of their work in producing an informative leaflet to encourage visitors to the site.
