The rules regarding astro turf and any objects around a grave to be highlighted for future plots.

A cemetery wall of plaques is also to be considered for people who could not afford or did not wish to have a headstone.

It was agreed that the cemetery regulations would be updated and brought back to the next meeting for approval and the Clerk would look into purchasing a 'wall'.

Cllr Greenwood commented on the cemeteries looking really good and asked for the workmen to be thanked for all their efforts.
