The Clerk will apply for another grant for a bus shelter for the bottom of All Saints Park, going towards Tavistock (Tavistock side of the junction into All Saints Park).

Car Parks



Concern about the car park at Calstock becoming worse; contractors are lined up but the weather has been too poor. The Clerk to contact them to ask that it is made a priority.

**6. DOG BIN AT COX PARK**

Cllr Flashman has granted £500 for a dog bin a Cox Park – this amount will include the cost of emptying it (for a while).

**7. CHAIN AT SLIPWAY, CALSTOCK**

Mr Russell emailed with ongoing concerns about parking on the slipway, causing obstruction for people wishing to launch boats. This is an ongoing problem with no obvious solution. It was suggested that posters be put up along with a chain (that is not actually padlocked) to see if this deters car owners from parking there. The Clerk will price up the cost of heavy planters (like the ones in Callington) which may make a pleasant feature and be harder to remove.
