4. <u>APPROVE MINUTES: 22-11-17 & 21-02-18</u>

5. <u>BURIAL GUIDELINES FOR GRAVES – UPDATE</u>

These had been updated from the last meeting, disseminated and were approved.

6. <u>CEMETERY WALL – CREMATED REMAINS/GRAVE STONES</u>

Pascoe's have supplied a quote for a wall to have plaques for cremated remains. The Burial Board felt this would be a lovely addition for both cemeteries but requested that Cornish granite be used. **Proposal/resolution:** to confirm with Pascoe's that the walls can be erected, asking for Cornish granite if possible (Cllr Wakem, Cllr Greenwood – unanimous).

Pascoe's have also asked whether a granite slab can be placed on the length/width of a grave as they have had a request from a customer. There was discussion about whether there would be settlement but so long as this is mitigated against and remains the responsibility of the stonemason it was deemed to be acceptable. The Clerk was asked to get advice on the fee for allowing one from the stonemasons.

7. <u>BENCH REQUEST</u>

A bench has been requested for Susan Whale who used to work at Pearce's. It was agreed that a bench next to the new cremated remains wall would be a good addition so was approved.
