<u>Last Post -</u> Cllr Kirk has confirmed that the Last Post and other relevant songs will be performed at the ceremony

<u>School involvement</u> – Cllr Latham has spoken to the Headteacher of Gunnislake and Delaware Schools who has confirmed that two children will march with the Parish Council – she will also make contact with Calstock and Harrowbarrow School when they return in September. Some of the children's artwork can also be exhibited it was suggested that the children could read some pieces they have been working on.

<u>Lesley Smith – Cllr Wilkes</u> has left a message and will try to make contact again <u>Saltash Town Band</u> – Cllr Rooker has confirmed they are pleased to be playing again and will continue to be the liaison for them

Tamar Valley Centre – the building has been booked

<u>Archives</u> – the Parish Archives were not planning on holding an exhibition but has said they can put up a display

<u>Rev Painter</u> – an order of service has been used for the last two years; and he would like to be involved again this year. He confirmed that Calstock church bells will ring at 11.00am (along with



many other church bells) but Cllr Kirk questioned this asking if the minute's silence would be at 11.00am – Rev Painter will confirm this. Poppies will be displayed on the outside of Gunnislake Public Hall from mid-October.
