Harrowbarrow – again the committee felt that having a maintenance contract in place was  
worthwhile for this equipment, it was also noted that the fence around the toddler park had  
been removed.

other 3 sites and the working party being set up for the skateboard ramp may also look at  
some new equipment here. The clerk was asked to contact a welder for the slide to remove  
the rusty area at the top.

Gunnislake – the committee liked the new equipment and noted that the new fence was  
keeping the dogs out.

The committee wanted to thanks the maintenance men for their hard work in keeping the play  
areas clean and tidy.
