Playground

As everybody is aware the skateboard area has had to be dismantled as it is unsafe. The parish council have received quotes to replace the area; one of which was £100,000! St Anns Chapel play ground is the next area to be upgraded but, the parish council has little money to invest on the project. The committee is obtaining information about grants and other quotes to replace the play equipment in the field. Wainhomes have donated £500 to Calstock Parish council for the equipment. This won't go very far. Our fundraising events will go towards funding the upgrade.

The committee explained to Dorothy that a long term aim for the community group is to push for a community centre for St Ann's Chapel. For, although we are rapidly becoming the largest community in the parish we lack facilities that other villages have. Dorothy stated there is no money for such a venture at present. This won't deter us for fighting our corner.

One of our aims as a group is to bring the community together. The committee are suggesting the following 2 new groups:
