PROPOSAL/RESOLUTION:

The Parish Council were minded to support this application but feels they are unable to due to the Cornwall Plan; Policy 26 Flood Risk Management and Coastal Change 2F and 2G - F. supports community-led local Consultation on the Cornwall Local Plan - and G. does not create avoidable future liability for maintenance for public bodies and communities. Although the Tamar Community Trust have worked hard on the bridging of the breach and its design but it does not appear in the application, and there are insufficient assurances as to the guaranteed location of the footpath or its maintenance and liability and detailed engineered drawings relating to the construction of the bridge. There are also concerns about inadequate reports received on adjoining properties (proposed: Cllr Wilkes, seconded: Cllr Wells – 1 abstention, others in favour).
