3. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

4. TAMAR INN, CALSTOCK: LICENSING AND USE OF VILLAGE GREEN

Discussion took place as to the use of the green for consuming alcohol and potential risks associated. Generally, the Council felt that using the Village Green creates a good atmosphere in Calstock.

Proposal/Resolution: to write to the Licensing Compliance Officer to support the Tamar Inn in amending their licence to include (as advised by the Licensing Officer):

- Staff to check if drinks are being taking outside
- Provide toughened glass that can be reused for outside use
- For the condition to be relaxed at 10.00pm (no further outside use)
- Staff to check hourly and clear away any glasses and litter
- Additional notices to be placed requesting patrons to act responsibly

And to also write to the Social Club and Village Hall outlining this good practice.
