3. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

4. <u>APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST MEETING – 28-01-2020</u>

Proposal/Resolution: the minutes be approved. Proposed: Cllr Polglase, seconded: Cllr Wakem – unanimous.

5. CALSTOCK CAR PARK REPAIRS

Four contractors have submitted quotes for short-term repair works on the car parks. Two of the contractors suggested a longer-term solution will be to tarmac. The short-term solutions were difficult to compare as they were very varied, two not giving details at all. It was agreed that the Clerks would ask MJ Troup and Mike Bray to provide another quote based on a specification that would include the re-use of the existing pavers where possible and the Committee will reconvene next week to discuss.

6. PARKING ENFORCMENT

Enforcement is not being initiated now because there is no charge for the car park, however officers are looking at roads around the car parks. The Clerk is liaising with enforcement on a Service Level Agreement. It was reported that cars are parking on the pavement at St Ann's Chapel. Clerks to report to the PCSOs.



7. <u>COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH</u>

The Community Network is meeting (virtually) next week. Clarification is required on what initiatives are being processed through the £50,000 funding via the Community Network and what is coming directly from Cornwall Council. The initiatives that are expected are:

- Mobile speed cameras which issue fines (to be shared with other network areas)
- Traffic calming strategies such as pedestrian crossings/chicanes
- Community training to use volunteers to capture the speed of vehicles and issue letters to deter further speeding (not to issue penalties).
