1. APOLOGIES

2. DECLARATIONS OF MEMBERS' INTERESTS

3. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Jim Milne Davidson outlined some ideas about canoe storage on Parish Quay.

4. APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST MEETING – 18-02-2020

Proposal/Resolution: to approve the minutes of the last meeting (proposed: Cllr Riggs, seconded: Cllr Wakem - unanimous).

5. PARISH QUAY – CANOE STORAGE AND FLOATING PONTOON

Jim Milne Davidson outlined an idea he has for storing canoes and kayaks along the back wall of Parish Quay from using scaffold poles. He feels there is room for a structure that could hold up to 30 vessels and this is likely to tidy up the main waterfront area. A nominal fee of £25 could be charged per year with each 'cabin' numbered to keep track of leases. He also mooted the idea of a floating pontoon.

All ideas were very well received by those in attendance and Jim was asked if he would be prepared to commit some ideas onto paper so that we can procure suitable quotes to get a true cost of financing the project and applying for funding if necessary.



6. USE OF PONTOON: PLEASURE BOATS/FLOATING PONTOON

There was limited time to discuss this, but it was agreed that the Clerk will contact the pleasure boat and explain a floating pontoon will be used for an outdoor company to store their water vessels.

7. PARKING BY SLIPWAY: YELLOW LINE HATCHINGS

It was agreed that the hatchings need to be painted within the yellow lines to prevent people from parking in the space between the two lines.

8. GRANT FUNDING VIA AONB

It was explained in order to progress any funding through the RDPE stream that the AONB is applying for, three quotes will be necessary.
