



Minutes from the **Forest for Calstock Parish Advisory Committee** held on,

1. Apologies

2. Approve minutes from meeting held 26-05-2021

Proposal/resolution: to approve previous minutes. Proposed, Gill Boreham, Seconded: Alastair Tinto – all.

3. Matters Arising

Woodland Trust Application – Gill Court reported that we do not qualify for this grant.

Weed mats and guards – Lesley advised that these types of items are used elsewhere in Forest for Cornwall projects – John found that the cost would be £40-£45 for 400, about 10p each.

Delaware School – Gill Boreham has contacted the school who are keen to be involved in some way – Gill Boreham and Gill Court will get back to the school and work out a suitable programme

Queens Green Canopy – Gill Boreham circulated information about this; it will be a good Phase 2 initiative and may work well with the Parish Council taking ownership of Fosters Field

4. Oak saplings

The National Trust are storing the oaks. Theo confirmed with Stuart Wood that we would like 50 to be earmarked for our work in Phase 2. John and Theo have worked on a press release and this will be sent out via the Clerks at an appropriate time.

5. Planting Schemes

Adrian Steel has been unable to quote for some of the items. Alastair was pleased with the pricing he has had so far. It was felt that to use the money raised from the Crowdfunding should be the priority and other grants can be used once this money has been spent. Alastair delegated the responsibility of ordering.

Gill Boreham is working up the planting schemes into CAD files and will use colour coded legends on the plans.

6. Maintenance Programme

Alastair and Clare will draw up a press release asking for volunteers to make contact – some people have already expressed an interest in getting involved. Longer term a co-ordinator will be sought from each locality to oversee the programmes of work.

7. People’s Trust for Endangered Species

Clare and Gill have sent through the information required to process this application.

8. Magic Little Grants

Alastair and Clare to work on this.

9. Terms of Reference

Clare had drafted TOR’s for approval by the Personnel Committee.

Proposal/resolution: to recommend these Terms of Reference. Proposed: John Wells, seconded Gill Boreham – unanimous.

10. New Tree Council Funding Stream

Lesley highlighted another potential funding stream which may be useful for hedgerow gapping – John and Alastair will liaise about this.
