## 6. RECREATIONAL AREA, CALSTOCK FIELD – CLLR WESTWOOD

A paper written by Cllr Westwood had been disseminated and discussion ensued about the various proposals within it.

Members of the Football Club were present and said they welcome better use of the side of the field, so long as the pitch itself is not compromised.

Members of the public raised concerns about the noise of a skate park if one were installed near housing on Marsh Lane.

There was general approval and support for Cllr Westwood to progress ideas and bring them back to the committee. She was also advised that if she set up a constitutionalised community group, this may draw in additional funding e.g. from Cllr Kirk's community chest.



#### 7. **PLAYBOAT MAITENANCE PROGRAMME**

The Clerk is still waiting for a costing for an annual maintenance programme for the Playboat. An estimate had been received from Alastair Guy that stated to reconstruct the boat from scratch would cost in the region of £65,000-£75,000 excluding safety surface material.
