**4. APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST MEETING – 05-10-2021**

**5. MATTERS ARISING**

**Reports from Skatepark visits** – Cllr Brown told the meeting that the best skatepark he had been to was Bodmin where the local maintenance man was very helpful. They had a budget of £500 for repairs and so far had not used it, Maverick came occasionally to check over the park and do any necessary repairs free of charge. It appeared to be easy to maintain and well used.

**Grants and Funding Plan** – This was covered in the presentation by Maverick

**Going over plot size and Material quantities (working out square footage of materials)** – this was not covered.

**St Ann's wider scrub and woodland** – Cllr Westwood also spoke about this as she had been contacted by members of the public who wanted to set up a BMX track on the scrubby bit of land in front of the proposed site of the skateboard park. The clerk explained that others in the past have offered to do this but nothing has ever materialised. It was suggested that the skatepark be finalised first before going ahead with the BMX track.

**6. MAVERICK PRESENTATION**

Russ Holbert from Maverick explained what his company could do if they were invited to tender, he also explained the actions to take in the right order.

- First have a site,
-



- second get planning permission,
- third put together a tender and if you have a design send that with the tender.
- Once the tenders have gone out and you decide a preferred contractor then it would be easier to put the funding in place.
- Maverick would help with this and the consultation process.

It was agreed that the Clerk would look to find 2 other skatepark builders to come and present if possible.

**7. CLLR WESTWOOD** - Cllr Westwood - discussion regarding parishioners coming forward to suggest and volunteer to construct bike park in area – see matters arising.
