



COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP 2021-2022

All Committees except for Advisory Committees will be able to hold and manage budgets subject to the approval of the Council and the standard financial controls.

In the case of Committees that have responsibility for physical assets or ongoing projects, budgets will be set by the Council at the start of each year to maintain and manage these assets or project. All Committees can apply to the Council for a budget to complete a particular project that has been approved and specified by the Council.

A member of the Council who is not appointed to a committee may attend a committee meeting as a member of the public. They would have the same rights as a member of the public and therefore have no right to vote on the matter they wish to speak about.

The Council will continue to appoint non-Councillors to committees, if it sees fit, but would normally limit these members to 25% of total number on the committee. These non-Councillor members will have full voting rights on advisory committees but on all other committees their right to vote will be as prescribed by statute.

Members of the public can still attend any meetings as prescribed in (SO's) and can speak at the Chair's discretion but not be able to vote.

All appointed non-Councillors members of committees must agree to be bound by the Code of Conduct and Standing Orders and meet the required qualifications.

The Quorum for full Council will be one third of the total membership
For all other committee there should be at least 50% of its full voting members present or a minimum of 3 whichever is greater
