5. **Invitation by Planning Officer to reassess PA22/00463**

Proposal/resolution: Although the site is outside the Settlement Development Boundary in the Neighbourhood Development Plan, it does comply with CLP Policy 7.3. However, on reassessing the information it was felt that the parking issues are a concern. Land ownership was queried by the members of the public present and these issues would need to be resolved before the Parish Council can support the application – evidence would need to be given that enough parking could be given without the loss of parking to 2 Chapel Cottages.
