Regulations for the Memorial Wall and Plaques in Albaston and Calstock Cemeteries

The memorial wall is for small plaques which can be purchased from the Clerk's office and affixed to the memorial wall. Permission will be granted for a name and significant dates on the plaque which are 2" high and 6" wide. The purchase price is £40.00 payable to Calstock Parish Council. The plaque will remain in place for a minimum of 25 years (unless it becomes unduly weathered and/or illegible).

A larger plaque can be ordered at 10" high and 6" wide – price on request.

If you so desire, you can scatter the ashes in the flower bed adjacent to the wall. Please do not scatter any ashes anywhere else in the cemetery.

The Parish Council will undertake the planting of bulbs and shrubs and will maintain the area.

The above fee is applicable from 10th October 2019 and was approved by Calstock Parish Council on 9th October 2019.
