<u>#Toilets cleaning schedule</u>: cleaned daily Monday – Friday and once over the weekend. It is recommended this is reviewed in the summer, certainly at Calstock, where two cleans a day are likely to be required. The Cleaning Company have requested that if anyone notices mess in the toilets they log the date and time so it can be cross referenced with their cleaning schedule. At the moment the cleaners are opening the toilets over the weekend, incurring further cost, and it would seem most cost effective to leave them open all the time and review if issues arise.
