<u>Calstock Cemetery</u> – a production team have visited and are keen to film some excavation – not confirmed as yet.

8. CEMETERY MAINTENANCE



The site was visited, and it was agreed that headstones need further efforts to remove ivy and brambles. Pascoe's are due to carry out work on the kerbed graves for health and safety, but the vegetation is impeding their work. Tracy has been in contact with Tesco's, and they can provide a team of people – a brief to be written so that they know what is being asked of them. It was agreed to try for a Thursday afternoon in September when some workers may be able to help on their way home.

Jobs required by volunteers/contractors: edges of paths tidied with moss etc scraped away; hedges cut back; yew trees tidied.

9. REVIEW BUDGETS AND CAPITAL WORKS PROGRAMME

Budgets were noted. It was discussed about looking at additional staffing for a dedicated member of staff to look after the cemeteries.
