<u>Gunnislake road improvements</u> – further discussion ensued about Gunnislake village road improvements – it was suggested by the Clerk that a list be put together by Cllr Wells and the Ward Members to initially be sent to Highways and to follow up on initiatives that are not within Highways' planned maintenance schedule.

Proposal/resolution: for Gunnislake toilets to be reopened for 7 days a week with 6 cleans a week but for them to be closed overnight and at weekends should there be signs of deliberate misuse/vandalism. Proposed: Cllr Warwick; seconded: Cllr Spurr – unanimous.
