#### 2. Declarations of Members' Interests

#### 3. Public Participation

Members of Gunnislake Community Members were present and spoke during the agenda item about use of the Gunnislake facilities.

#### 4. Approve minutes of last meetings: 28-10-2025

The minutes from 28-10-2025 were approved. Proposed: Cllr Alford, seconded: Cllr Clarke

#### 5. Matters Arising: –

- Local Maintenance Partnership enhanced capital works grant - £12,320 now confirmed (repairs to paths at Cox Park, Danescombe and Gunnislake) – this was noted.

#### 6. Football Club request to use Gunnislake facilities

After a lengthy discussion it was proposed that only St Ann's Chapel is offered for the next season as the amount of work to bring the facilities to standard are too prohibitive, the pitch is already waterlogged and a lot of items are stored in there for the whole community's benefit.

Proposal/resolution: only offer St Ann's Chapel for the next season . Proposed: Cllr Warwick; seconded: Cllr Greenwood. 5 in favour; 1 objection (Cllr Wakem), 1 abstention (Cllr Spurr).

#### 7. Zip Wire, Harrowbarrow: three quotes received

Proposal/resolution: to approve Option 2 from Sutcliffe Play. Proposed: Cllr Clarke; seconded: Cllr Spurr- unanimous.

It was agreed that the Chair and staff will see if they can negotiate some of the costs.

**8. Standing Item: Fosters Field – consultations**

It was agreed that wider public consultations will continue in the New Year, the results of which will be fed back to the Receptions Committee.
